REQUEST FOR ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENA FOR WITNESS TAMMY WEBB

TO THE CLERK OF THE COURT:

COMES NOW Jeremy Black, Defendant/Plaintiff in this matter, and respectfully requests the issuance of a subpoena for the attendance and testimony of Tammy Webb at the hearing set for June 17, 2026, or at such other date and time as the Court may direct.

Name of Witness: Tammy Webb

Reason for Testimony:

Tammy Webb's testimony is material, relevant, and necessary to issues before the Court, including custody, visitation, parental fitness, credibility of the parties and witnesses, the

children's best interests, and the circumstances surrounding the events of July 6, 2024 and related communications.

Based on the record and prior sworn statements, Tammy Webb has personal knowledge that is directly relevant to the Court's determination. Specifically, the available materials show that Tammy Webb was contacted before arrival, arrived after the incident, did not personally witness the alleged altercation, and relied on information supplied before her arrival rather than firsthand observation.[1] Her testimony is therefore necessary to explain:

1. What she was told before arriving;
2. What communications she had with Teshia Black before and after arriving;
3. The basis for any statements she made concerning Jeremy Black;
4. Whether her statements were based on personal knowledge or information received from others;
5. Any coordination, inconsistency, or narrative shaping relevant to the parties' credibility and the children's best interests.

The evidence also reflects that Tammy Webb sent a text stating, among other things, that "I haven't lied," that "no one out of 3 cops spoke to me," and that the dispute was "between you and Teshia," which is relevant to her knowledge, involvement, and the extent to which she claims no role in causing the arrest or the resulting separation from the children.[2]

Further, the checklist prepared in Jeremy Black's case specifically identifies Tammy Webb as a key witness for subpoena in advance of trial, confirming her importance to the defense presentation.[3]

Tammy Webb is further commanded to produce any texts, emails, call logs, screenshots, notes, recordings, social media communications, or other documents in her possession, custody, or control relating to Jeremy Black, Teshia Black, Diane Parker, the children, the July 6, 2024 incident, any alleged assault or emergency call, and any communications regarding custody, visitation, or efforts to influence statements made to law enforcement or the Court.

Jeremy Black respectfully requests that the subpoena issue compelling Tammy Webb to appear and testify at the June 17, 2026 hearing and, if applicable, to produce any relevant documents , texts, messages, notes, recordings, or communications concerning Teshia Black, Diane Parker, Jeremy Black, the children, or the July 6, 2024 incident.
