

# PATTERN OF MARRIAGES AND SYSTEMIC MANIPULATION — THE TEACHING EXAMPLE OF TESHIA BLACK

## A. Introduction: How One Woman Turned the System Into a Weapon

For more than a decade, **Teshia Black** has used marriage not as a bond, but as a means of leverage.

Each new relationship became another opportunity to craft a new story, a new accusation, and a new way to profit from the legal machinery of Cocke County.

Since **July 6 2024**, her strategy has reached its most dangerous form—transforming falsehoods into arrests, transforming courts into accomplices, and transforming justice itself into an instrument of personal gain.

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## B. The Pattern Hidden in Plain Sight

Six marriages. Six divorces. Six different narratives of victimhood—each tailored to the courtroom she happened to be standing in.

Every accusation was different. The result was always the same: **Teshia wins, the spouse loses, and the court records another “victim” judgment in her favor.**

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### **C. Exploiting the Machinery of Cocke County**

1. **Tailoring the Allegation to the Audience** – Abuse for sympathy, infidelity for moral authority, mental illness for pity.
  2. **Aligning with Insiders** – Marrying an attorney, cultivating prosecutors, and securing favor from local judges created a feedback loop of credibility.
  3. **Weaponizing Procedure** – When evidence contradicted her, officials “lost” records, denied access, or refused investigation.
  4. **Financial Extraction** – With each case came possession of homes, vehicles, and federal benefits—never earned, always acquired by legal default.
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### **D. How the Scheme Escalated After July 6 2024**

The evening of **July 5 2024**, Teshia was told the marriage was over.

By **10 a.m. the next day**, her husband—a **100 percent disabled combat-medic veteran**—was in jail.

The arrest rested on perjured statements later proven false by body-cam and transcript evidence.

Within days, she lived **rent-free in an \$800,000 home**, drove a **\$100,000 Yukon Denali**, and began collecting **federal dependent benefits** she had redirected with falsified custody paperwork.

When the school counselor reported child abuse on **March 18 2025**, she moved the children to a private counselor “recommended” by her attorney **Crystal Jesse**—a counselor known for soft-pedaling abuse. The result was predictable: the reports stopped, and oversight vanished.

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### **E. The Protective Wall Around Her**

None of it could have lasted without help.

- **DA Jimmy Dunn** and **ADA Nikolas Kear** ignored written notices of benefit theft and perjury.
- **Sheriff C.J. Ball** and **Lt. Zach Magourik** blocked evidence requests and refused investigation.
- **Judges Mark Strange** and **Carter S. Moore** enforced tainted orders while suppressing discovery.

This network of inaction and selective prosecution turned her private misconduct into a **state-sanctioned fraud**—a textbook case of **official oppression** under **T.C.A. § 39-16-403** and **18 U.S.C. §§ 241–242**.

- **Benefit Fraud:** 42 U.S.C. § 408(a)(5); 38 U.S.C. §§ 6101–6108; 18 U.S.C. § 641
- **Obstruction / Brady Giglio:** 18 U.S.C. §§ 1503, 1512, 1519
- **Retaliation / Witness Tampering:** 18 U.S.C. § 1513; T.C.A. § 39-16-510
- **Official Oppression / Conspiracy:** 18 U.S.C. §§ 241–242; T.C.A. § 39-16-403

## H. The Human Cost

Fifteen months without a father's voice.

Four children cut off from their only consistent parent.

Federal benefits diverted, counseling manipulated, truth buried under procedure.

While officials looked the other way, an entire family was dismantled—piece by piece—under the pretense of “justice.”

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## I. Conclusion: Why This Matters

This is more than one family's tragedy; it is a **case study in how personal deceit becomes public corruption** when institutions choose loyalty over law.

Teshia Black's marriages were not coincidences—they were campaigns.

Her success depended on a courthouse that refused to question her, a sheriff's office that refused to act, and prosecutors who forgot who the victims really are.

If this pattern can thrive in Cocke County, it can thrive anywhere.

Transparency and accountability are not optional—they are the only antidote.

## Marriage History & Allegations

### 1. Husband #1 (Married Twice)

- Allegation: Claimed he beat her.
- Contradiction: She remarried him after the first divorce despite the alleged abuse.
- Outcome: Second divorce was granted to her on grounds of *Inhumane Treatment*.
- **Pattern:** Contradictory behavior (remarrying an alleged abuser), using abuse claims to secure divorce grounds.

### 2. Husband #2 (100% Disabled Veteran)

- Allegation: Claimed he “developed multiple personalities.”
- Outcome: Divorce.
- **Pattern:** Used mental health accusations to undermine a disabled veteran, mirroring her current tactics of weaponizing health claims.

### 3. Husband #3 (Attorney)

- Allegation: He previously represented her in previous divorce.
- Outcome: Divorce.
- **Pattern:** Marriage appeared to provide her with legal leverage, showing strategic use of relationships in court disputes.

### 4. Husband #4

- Allegation: Claimed he cheated on her.
- Outcome: Divorce, with Teshia ordered to pay alimony.
- **Pattern:** Shifted the victim narrative to infidelity after financial loss, consistent with portraying herself as powerless despite contradictory outcomes.

### 5. Husband #5 (Jeremy Black – Plaintiff)

- Allegation: Claimed to be a helpless, scared victim in criminal and divorce proceedings.
- Contradictions:

- False and perjured testimony documented in court records.
  - Suppressed child abuse disclosures.
  - Fraudulent redirection of Social Security and VA dependent benefits.
  - Outcome: Divorce pending.
  - **Pattern:** Same playbook of false victimhood and legal weaponization applied in current litigation.
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### Context on Plaintiff

- At the time of meeting Teshia, Plaintiff Jeremy Black was completing his own divorce.
  - That divorce was won on grounds of *Inhumane Treatment and Marital Misconduct*.
  - This provides context for how Teshia later mirrored similar allegations for her own advantage.
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### Summary of Pattern

- **Repetition:** Six marriages, six divorces, each ending with Teshia portraying herself as the victim.
- **Contradiction:** Allegations vary widely — abuse, mental illness, infidelity, helplessness — depending on which narrative benefits her most.
- **Manipulation:** Use of marital relationships to gain legal, financial, or strategic advantages.
- **Relevance:** This pattern directly impacts her credibility in both criminal and divorce proceedings, and supports the broader civil rights and fraud claims pending in federal court.

# Summary of Criminal Acts and Concealment – Teshia Black

## A. False Reports and Perjury (T.C.A. §§ 39-16-502, 39-16-703; 18 U.S.C. § 1621)

- **Dates:** July 6, 2024 – August 14, 2025
  - **Conduct:**
    - Filed **false police statements** leading to your unlawful arrest.
    - **Changed written statements** under the guidance of Deputy Josh Smith to omit that Jeremy restrained Daniel Black after witness said it did not happen and it was a blur after Teshia intervened (child abuse).
    - Repeatedly **lied under oath** in hearings (Jan. 22, 2025 and Aug. 14, 2025) while protected by Judge Mark Strange ADA Kear and DA Dunn.
  - **Shielding Officials:**
    - Judge Mark Strange, DA Dunn and ADA Kear refused to prosecute her for perjury despite audio and court transcripts proving the lies.
    - Judges Moore and Strange ignored clear inconsistencies and continued enforcing her false claims.
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## B. Child Abuse and Suppression of Reporting (T.C.A. § 37-1-403; 18 U.S.C. § 241 – conspiracy against rights)

- **Conduct:**
  - Suppressed children's disclosures to **school counselor and CPS**, moving them to a **private counselor known for minimizing abuse**.
- **Shielding Officials:**

- DA's office and CCSO **blocked formal complaints**, refused investigation, and denied bodycam access.
  - Judges Strange and Moore refused to order release of exculpatory CPS records or bodycam footage.
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### **C. Social Security & VA Benefits Fraud (42 U.S.C. § 408(a)(5); 38 U.S.C. §§ 6101–6108)**

- **Conduct:**
    - **Falsified dependency status** and redirected children's Social Security dependent benefits after manipulating court orders.
    - Interfered with Plaintiff's VA disability benefits through fraudulent filings and misleading representations of custody status.
  - **Shielding Officials:**
    - Judge Strange's refusal to correct fraudulent orders allowed ongoing misuse of federal funds.
    - DA Dunn and ADA Kear ignored direct written notice of benefit theft and continued to back her narrative.
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### **D. Obstruction of Justice and Suppression of Exculpatory Evidence (18 U.S.C. §§ 1503, 1505, 1512, 1519; Brady/Giglio violations)**

- **Conduct:**
  - CCSO, DA's office, and court personnel **withheld bodycam and dashcam footage**, witness statements, and CPS reports.
  - Officials repeatedly misled you about existence of evidence (Keith Haas reported stonewalling).

- **Shielding Officials:**
    - Sheriff Ball, Lt. Magourik, and Deputy Smith coordinated refusals under instruction from DA's office.
    - Judges Moore and Strange allowed the state to proceed despite the absence of discovery, violating due process.
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## **E. Retaliation and Witness Intimidation (18 U.S.C. § 1513; T.C.A. § 39-16-510)**

- **Conduct:**
    - After you filed federal suit (2:25-cv-00002), officials retaliated by imposing an **ankle monitor** on Jan. 22, 2025, at Teshia's request.
    - Teshia, ADA Kear, and Judge Strange collaborated to **add witnesses (Tammy, Diane, Natasha)** to a bond order originally tied to her protection order.
  - **Shielding Officials:**
    - Judge Mark Strange, DA Dunn and Kear facilitated retaliatory actions to punish your protected federal filing.
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## **F. Conspiracy Under Color of Law (18 U.S.C. §§ 241, 242; T.C.A. § 39-16-403 – Official Oppression)**

- **Conduct:**
  - Teshia's false statements triggered arrests and prosecutions **designed to silence you** and obstruct evidence exposure.
  - Coordinated misconduct between CCSO, DA's office, and judges shows **organized protection of a civilian informant/beneficiary**.
- **Pattern Evidence:**

- Repeated denials of public records requests (Exhibits QQQQ and RR).
  - Coordinated refusal of service by DA Dunn and ADA Kear (Certified Mail logs).
  - Misuse of judicial power to reinforce fraudulent orders.
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## **G. Current Status – Ongoing Harm**

- **Financial:** Ongoing theft of federal benefits through misuse of custody orders.
- **Constitutional:** Continued deprivation of parental access, due process, and equal protection under the 1st, 5th, and 14th Amendments.
- **Psychological:** Manipulation of children through isolation, counselor suppression, and parental alienation tactics.

This exhibit summarizes a documented pattern of criminal acts and concealment by Defendant Teshia Black, enabled or ignored by officials within the Cocke County Sheriff's Office (CCSO), District Attorney Jimmy Dunn, Assistant District Attorney Nikolas Kear, Sheriff C.J. Ball, and Judges Mark Strange and Carter S. Moore. The actions outlined below demonstrate coordinated obstruction, selective prosecution, and retaliation under color of law.

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## **A. False Reports and Perjury**

**Statutes Violated:** T.C.A. §§ 39-16-502, 39-16-703; 18 U.S.C. § 1621

**Conduct:** Filed false police statements on July 6 and September 5, 2024 leading to unlawful arrest; altered written statement at Deputy Josh Smith's direction to omit Jeremy restraining Daniel Black; gave perjured testimony (Jan 22 and Aug 14 2025).

**Shielding Officials:** DA Dunn and ADA Kear refused prosecution despite audio/transcripts proving perjury; Judges Moore and Strange disregarded contradictions.

**Legal Authority:** Perjury and false reports under both Tennessee and federal law constitute obstruction of justice and deprivation of due process when knowingly ignored by officials.

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## **B. Child Abuse and Suppression of Reporting**

**Statutes Violated:** T.C.A. § 37-1-403; 18 U.S.C. § 241

**Conduct:** suppressed child-abuse disclosures by transferring children from school counselor to a private counselor known to minimize reports.

**Shielding Officials:** DA's office and CCSO blocked complaints, denied body-cam evidence, and ignored CPS disclosures.

**Legal Authority:** Failure to report or investigate child abuse violates mandatory-reporting duties and constitutes conspiracy against civil rights.

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### **C. Social Security and VA Benefits Fraud**

**Statutes Violated:** 42 U.S.C. § 408(a)(5); 38 U.S.C. §§ 6101–6108

**Conduct:** Falsified dependency status to redirect Social Security dependent benefits and interfere with Plaintiff's VA disability benefits through fraudulent court orders.

**Shielding Officials:** Judge Strange's refusal to correct fraudulent orders enabled continued misuse;

**Legal Authority:** Misuse of federal benefits constitutes federal fraud and theft of government property.

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### **D. Obstruction of Justice and Suppression of Exculpatory Evidence**

**Statutes Violated:** 18 U.S.C. §§ 1503, 1505, 1512, 1519; *Brady v. Maryland*, 373 U.S. 83 (1963); *Giglio v. United States*, 405 U.S. 150 (1972)

**Conduct:** CCSO, DA's office, and court staff withheld body-cam footage, dash-cam data, witness statements, and CPS records; officials misled Plaintiff and defense counsel about existence of evidence.

**Shielding Officials:** Sheriff Ball, Lt. Magourik, and Deputy Smith coordinated refusals under DA instruction; Judges Moore and Strange allowed prosecution to continue without discovery.

**Legal Authority:** Suppression of exculpatory evidence violates the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment.

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## **E. Retaliation and Witness Intimidation**

**Statutes Violated:** 18 U.S.C. § 1513; T.C.A. § 39-16-510

**Conduct:** After Plaintiff filed his federal complaint (2:25-cv-00002), officials retaliated by imposing an ankle monitor (Jan 22 2025) at Teshia Black's request; she, ADA Kear, and Judge Strange expanded a bond order to add witnesses Tammy Webb, Diane Parker, and Natasha Rick.

**Shielding Officials:** DA Dunn and Kear facilitated retaliation in violation of Plaintiff's First Amendment right to petition.

**Legal Authority:** Retaliating for protected legal activity violates federal law and constitutes obstruction of justice.

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## **F. Conspiracy Under Color of Law / Official Oppression**

**Statutes Violated:** 18 U.S.C. §§ 241, 242; T.C.A. § 39-16-403

**Conduct:** Coordinated use of false statements and unlawful prosecutions to silence Plaintiff and conceal misconduct.

**Evidence of Pattern:** Repeated denial of public-records requests (Exhibits QQQQ & RR); refusal of service by DA Dunn and ADA Kear; misuse of judicial authority to uphold fraudulent orders.

**Legal Authority:** Acting under color of law to deprive constitutional rights is a felony under 18 U.S.C. §§ 241–242 and a state offense of official oppression.

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## **G. Ongoing Harm**

- **Financial:** Continued theft of federal dependent benefits.
  - **Constitutional:** Denial of parental access and due process under the 1st, 5th, and 14th Amendments.
  - **Psychological:** Manipulation and alienation of minor children through isolation and counselor control.
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## **Conclusion**

These acts form a consistent pattern of fraud, obstruction, and retaliation carried out with assistance or acquiescence of local officials, establishing a continuing violation of Plaintiff's constitutional and statutory rights.
